8-9 Nov. 2018

During the 1st meeting it was developed a workshop with local stakeholders with the aim of sharing good practices, innovative teaching strategies and system actions to create multi-professional and intersectoral community networks both at European and at regional level.

Some of the scheduled interventions were made by the participants of the consortium, namely:

- Iole Marcozzi, of ilmiofuturo lead partner, illustrated the strategic assets on which the project operates, the innovative solutions that the partnership intends to develop and the research and training activities that will be carried out at European level and in the territories of the countries involved (Italy, Lithuania, Portugal, Romania);
- Carlo Di Michele of the USR Abruzzo drew an overview of the good practices in the light of the Guidelines elaborated by the MIUR Director's Cabin on school dispersion and educational poverty;
- Antonella Nuzzaci of the Department of Human Sciences of the University of L'Aquila, associate project partner, focused on innovative teaching strategies for a global and integrated school approach;
- Giulio Antonini, University representative for orientation and placement- Univeristà dell'Aquila illustrated regional systemic actions to support the fight against early school leaving in terms of the School-University research and training network;
- Nicola Renzetti of the Office for the Containment of School Dispersion of the Abruzzo Region illustrated in terms of public policies;
- The University of Targoviste, a project partner, presented its own system for the continuous and initial training of teachers that includes specific areas dedicated to the phenomenon of early school leaving.

- Agrupamento de Escolas de Águeda Sul-Águeda / Portugal


The schools discussed the characteristics of the school dispersion of each context and the predictive risk factors that, as evidenced by the Education and Training Monitoring Report (2017), can take different forms depending on the territorial realities.



Activity A1 | Web-survey for students and Early School Leavers

We developed a questionnaire addressed to:

- Students attending the last year of lower school (middle school);
- Students attending the first 2 years of upper school (high school);
- Early school leavers, already out school (young people between 18-24 year-old with less than upper-secondary qualification).

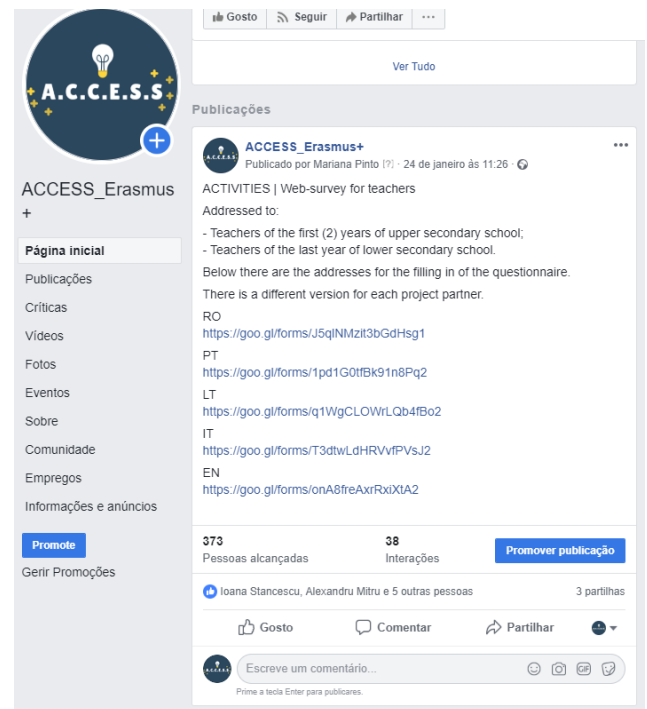
